



WINDOWS ON MAIN STREET—2010 Artists' Agreement

THE ARTISTS, THE ARTWORK, & THE AUDIENCE

The Windows On Main Street 2010 competition is open to artists in all disciplines.

The Selection Committee is looking for artwork that is both dynamic and innovative. The intended audience includes residents and visitors of all ages and backgrounds from Moorestown, surrounding communities, and beyond.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DECORATING THE WINDOW SASH:

- **Painting, Decorating and Sealing the historic Windows:** The Windows On Main Street committee will make available to each artist as many window sash as the artist requests. Artists may paint, decorate, or sculpt these structural artifacts as the artist desires. Artists may elect to prime the sash before painting it. Artists are cautioned that the existing sash may have lead-based paint on them and most do have their glass panes still intact. Some do have broken panes.
- **Alteration of the Basic Form:** Artists are permitted to add appendages that alter the basic sculptural form as long as the submitted design reveals a clear understanding of structural safety. Additional appendages or decorative embellishments added to the artwork must withstand human handling.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Windows On Main Street Committee reserves the right to select, in its sole discretion and for any reason, winning designs from those submitted to the project. The Windows Committee also reserves the right to reject, at its sole discretion, any design or finished work that includes advertising, refers to companies or other entities, reflects social disrespect, contains inappropriate slogans and/or images, or is deemed unacceptable by Windows Committee for any other reason. All designs are subject to the Committee's decision.

HONORARIUM

Artists chosen must sign this agreement with the Windows Committee and will be awarded a \$200 honorarium in payment for their completed and accepted Windows artwork.

OWNERSHIP

Once an artist's design(s) is chosen by the Selection Committee, the artist hereby assigns the copyright(s) to Windows On Main Street Committee, which shall have the right to reproduce and distribute the design(s) or any derivative of the design(s) for the purposes of promoting and advertising the event by all means of media. The Windows On Main Street Committee shall also have the right to use the design(s) or design(s) derivative on a variety of merchandise, as yet to be determined. No additional payment will be made to the artist for these rights. The completed Windows artwork / sculpture will be property of Windows On Main Street Committee.
