Dear Artist:

We invite you to participate in a project that will benefit the Moorestown Community House, and offer you an opportunity to create and sell an exciting work of art at a community event on May 8, 2010.

You will be asked to select, from an assortment of windows, one that inspires you to create a compelling work of art. A photograph showing some of the different kinds of windows is attached. We ask that you submit for approval by the committee a rough sketch and brief written description of your idea for a window, along with a resume, by **August 31, 2009**.

Once approved, you will be asked to:

1. Make an appointment with David Schill Restorations at 609-410-5969 or dwschill@comcast.net to pick up your window and return the attached Artists' Agreement form and the Artists' Release and Waiver of Liability form by September 15, 2009.
2. Send us a jpeg of your completed artwork *along with a brief statement about the work* by January 30, 2010.
3. Deliver your completed window in March 2010—the specific location and date(s) will be announced in the future. At the time you deliver your window, you will receive an honorarium of \$200.
